THE WORD

Try this. Draw three circles, each within the other – make them large, not tiny; then put a dot in the middle of the innermost circle. Write on the border of innermost circle the names of those who have handed on the faith to you, who taught you what it means to live your faith. These are the people we have known during our life.

Along the outermost circle record the names of the biblical people who have had an impact on your life – the women and men of the Old and New Testaments, of course, but also the authors of any books of the Bible that have had an impact on you. Finally, around the edge of the middle circle, write the names of anyone in the intervening two thousand years who has influenced you as a believer – saints with a capital “S” and a small “s”. This is your own personal “cloud of witnesses” spoken of in the letter to the Hebrews (12:1), who have surrounded you during your life, praying for you and urging you on to live more fully in Christ.

The circles are actually much larger in reality, but these are the ones who have taught us to be poor in spirit, to mourn injustices in the world, to be meek and merciful, pure of heart and peacemakers. They have embodied what it means to hunger and thirst for justice and to be willing to undergo suffering for the sake of our faith. How impoverished our lives would be without them. Today is a day to say thank you to God for all these men and women and for sending us Jesus, our “leader and perfecter of faith” (12:2), who continues to draw us into the life shared by the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
